



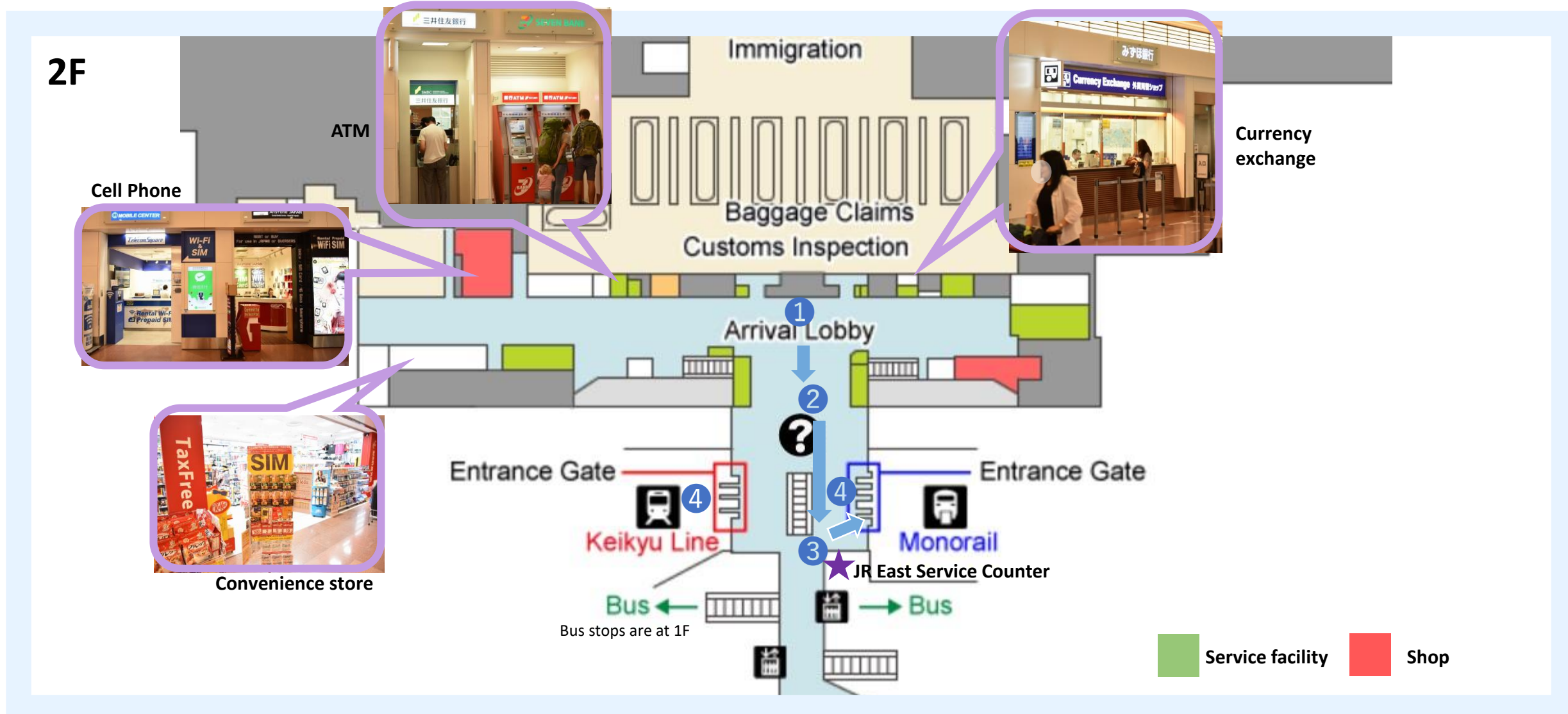

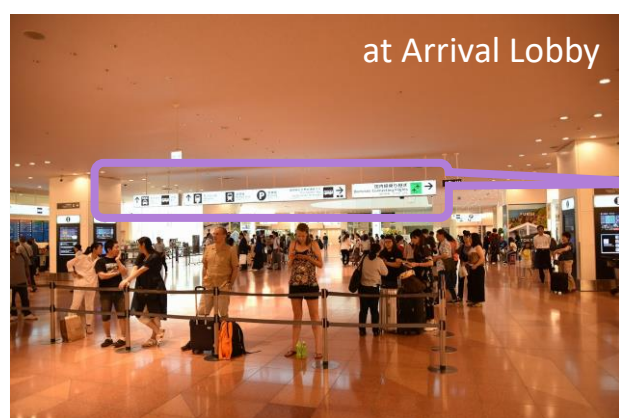

If you couldn't have enough time to purchase Shinkansen ticket at airport, . . . .



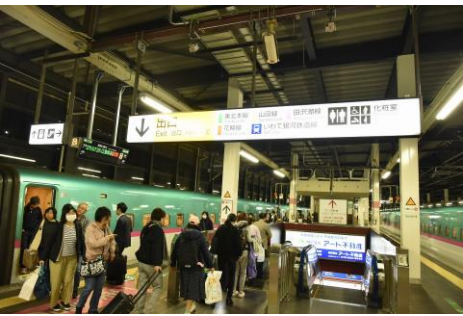
You are able to purchase Shinkansen tickets at any Shinkansen stations, such as Shinagawa, Tokyo, or Ueno. Ticket machines for Shinkansen are available for getting tickets. Also, you may ask the tickets in person at any Midori no Madoguchi, JR Ticket Service Counter.

If you need to go to Kuriyagawa Station, transfer to IGR (Iwate Ginga Railway), as following the sign.



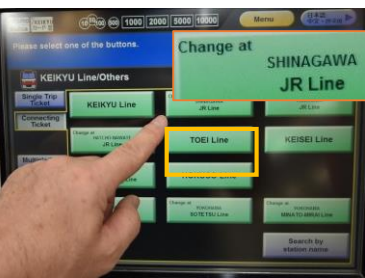
Kuriyagawa is a second stop from Morioka.

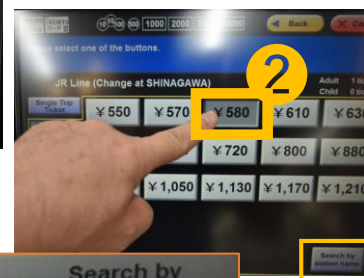




## How to purchase a Keikyu ticket

Select **Search by station name** when need to know how much the fare is for.

5 Here it is. Get your ticket. Don't forget the change.

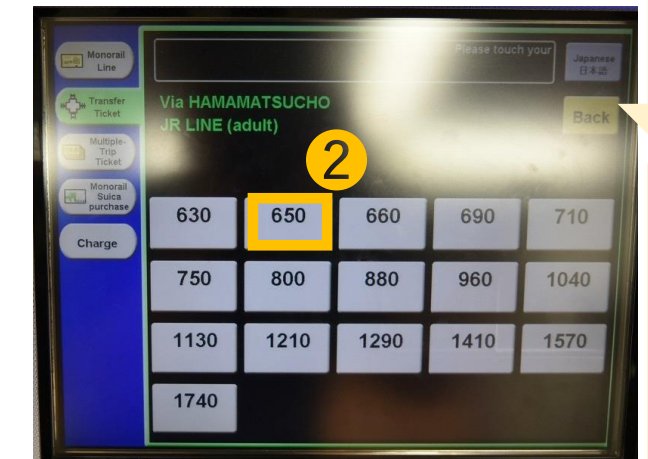
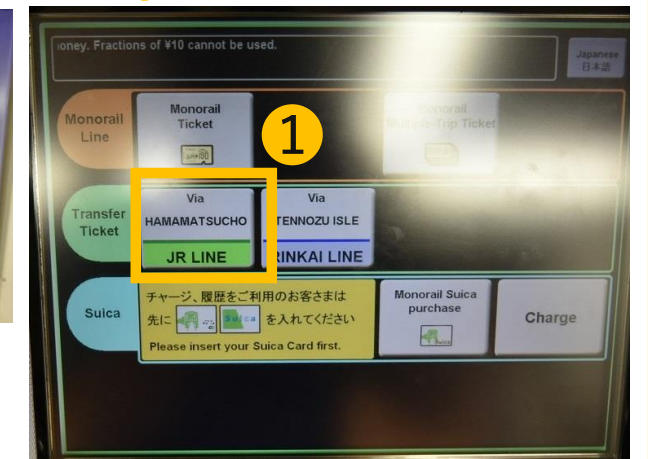


It is a sample ticket of Keikyu. It is **470yen** for JR Tokyo by way of Keikyu Shinagawa (Dec.2019).
