1. Narita Airport Station is an underground train station located beneath Terminal 1 of Narita International Airport. Airport Terminal 2 Station is also an underground railway station located beneath Terminal. The station serves both Terminal 2 and the nearby Terminal 3.

2. These stations are shared between East Japan Railway (JR) and the private railway operator Keisei Electric Railway. As a matter of convenience for you to avoid several transfers, this information mainly introduces the way of access by JR line.

We recommend you to purchase your whole ticket for Nasu-Shiobara at JR East Ticket Service Center where the assistant helps you with getting JR ticket in English.


